

Using IET with Babies and Small Children

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I have found that IET is wonderful for babies. My youngest client was a 1 day old boy who was in an incubator in the neonatal intensive care unit of a hospital. During his delivery he and his Mom underwent something like 14 hours of labor. When he finally arrived into the world he was severely jaundiced and was placed in an incubator under special lights. His blood chemistry was not good and the doctors feared that he might need advanced medical procedures. His mother had been a client of mine and since I am an Interfaith Minister, she asked me to visit the hospital as the family minister and "pray" for her newborn son.

At the hospital I was permitted to put my hands into the rubber gloves that provided access to the newborn. The child was so small I could not use the normal IET "hand" positions, since my hands were about as big as the entire child. Instead, I substituted "finger tip" positions and placed the fingertips of my index fingers on the baby's cellular memory areas where I would normally place my hands. It was incredible. I could not have imagined that a baby so small could take in so much energy, and I was almost sweating from the energy flowing from the angels through me to him.

The most amazing thing happened when I reached cellular memory 7 (the liver and gallbladder). I energized the area and touched the integration point for the liver and gall bladder and was almost blown back against the wall by the anger that shot out of this little child. In one sudden burst the child released all of the anger he and his Mom had built up during the long, long labor. As the energy of anger was released, I got the image of this baby being pressed for hours by contraction after contraction against a cervix that was not dilated enough to let him pass through. To put it bluntly, the little soul was very, very pissed off!

After releasing the anger, I completed the session (which had taken no more than 15 minutes) and left the hospital. Later that day the doctors must have been busy congratulating themselves on the incredible sudden clearing of the jaundice and the fact that the baby's blood chemistry returned to normal. The baby was released from intensive care and was very healthy after that.

In IET when we advise that practitioners avoid treating cellular memory area 8 on pregnant women especially when they are in their 3rd trimester. We do this because, one day while I was energizing the 8th cellular memory area on a pregnant client, I received angelic guidance that cautioned me to skip this area so as to avoid placing undue stress on the fetus. I did not receive any guidance that the energy could in any way harm the fetus, but rather, that since the fetus could not move away from the focus of angelic energy that was being channeled into it, the intensity of the energy might be stressful. Since the fetus would receive an abundance of energy as I energized the mother's other cellular memory areas, there was from the fetus's perspective really no need for me to treat cellular memory area 8.

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Once a fetus arrives into the world as a newborn it is very vocal about expressing their approval and disapproval. In general, when I do an IET session on a newborn, the child giggles with delight and almost lights up with joy from the angelic energy. If at any time, however, the newborn expresses their disapproval by crying or moving around as if to move away from the energy, then I simply stop working directly with the child and move away from the child, often to another room, and continue the IET session absentee.

The smaller the child, the faster the session. Since newborns have not had the time to develop the ability to suppress and hold onto layers of cellular memory, I have observed that they release suppressed cellular memory quickly and completely. It is not unusual to be able to do a complete IET session on a newborn in about 10 to 15 minutes.

As children get older (especially when they are around 2 to 6 years old) I have found that sometimes they are shy and a bit intimidated by the idea of an IET practitioner placing their hands on them. When this happens, I invite the child's parent, typically Mom, to act as my surrogate for the session. I have Mom put the child on her lap, and as I place my hands on Mom's cellular memory areas, I have Mom place her hands on the same cellular memory areas on the child. In this way, not only does Mom receive an IET session, but the IET energy channels through Mom and into the child who also receives an IET session.

If you are ever in doubt about whether or not to using an IET technique like the Heartwave with a newborn simply start by doing the technique absentee. In that way, you cannot force the newborn to receive the IET energy. They will receive it only if, and when, they are ready. After you do the absentee technique, observe the newborns reaction. In most cases you will likely see them react quickly and positively to the angelic IET energy. After witnessing this positive reaction, you can feel reassured that it is OK to begin bringing the IET energy to the child through the hand's on version of the technique, remembering as you do that if the child expresses approval and delight then you can continue, but if the child expresses disapproval then you simply stop and go back to using absentee techniques.
