

Integrated Energy Therapy Practitioner's Code of Ethics

Definition and Purpose of IET: As an IET practitioner, we channel IET Angelic Energy into cellular memory areas to rebalance and clear the energy of the body's cellular memory as well as the energy of the Human Energy Field. As IET practitioners we support the body's natural ability to establish and maintain proper energetic balance.

IET'S Objective: The objective of IET is to provide a simple and gentle way to open the flow of vital life force within the human body and Human Energy Field by integrating suppressed feelings from cellular memory and clearing their associated energy blockages.

Setting Intention: IET practitioners work together with their clients in setting the intention to work in harmony with the IET Angelic Energy to support the client's self-healing process.

Principles of Self-Healing: IET Practitioners support clients in their self-healing process. Practitioners know that self-healing is a personal, individualized process that occurs from within the client's inner dimension. The IET practitioner supports the client by creating a space of angelic love energy.

Professionalism: IET Practitioners are expected to maintain a high standard of professionalism in their practice. They are expected to treat clients and colleagues with respect, courtesy, care and consideration. IET Practitioner's must respect their client's individuality and beliefs. They must respect the client's right to be involved in their treatment and they empower the client to give feedback, alter or discontinue the session at any time. The client's inner process, spiritual practices and pacing of self-healing are respected and supported.

Professional Responsibility: IET practitioners must practice with integrity and follow this Code of Ethics through their words and actions. IET Practitioners must not step beyond the ability of their credentials. All clients are encouraged to be responsible in the use and choice of professional assistance as needed to support their self-healing process.
